## LENNOX MUSIC – mp3 Download Instructions

### To download to a Windows PC:

1. On the Music Catalogue page, click or tap on the key link in the left hand column.
2. On the Catalogue Information page, confirm the song listing and the price.
3. Click or tap on the key link in the left hand column to download the EP or album.
4. If using Chrome, the download window will appear in the bottom left hand corner with a progress bar.
5. When the download is complete, click the right mouse button on the file in the downloads window.
6. Click on the up arrow next to the Zip file and Select Show in folder.
7. Windows will open an Explorer window with the zip file selected.
8. Click the right mouse button and select Extract All... You can choose to extract the zip file in this folder, or copy and paste it to a different folder.
9. In the Extract Compressed (Zipped) Folders dialog box, click on Extract
10. A new folder with the Catalogue release will be created. You will then find the mp3 files in that folder.

### To download to an Android phone:

1. On the Music Catalogue page, click or tap on the key link in the left hand column.
2. On the Catalogue Information page, confirm the song listing and the price.
3. Click or tap on the key link in the left hand column to download the EP or album.
4. The file will download – Downloading file – details..
5. When the download is complete, tap on Open and select your Android file viewer app such as CX File Explorer.
6. Select the menu in the top right hand corner with three dots and select Extract All
7. Select Extraction Path, Main storage, select the folder on the phone where you want to store the music, e.g: Music, tap on Extract Here.
8. Go to your mp3 player app on the phone e.g: VLC Media Player
9. Tap on the three dots menu in the top right hand corner and select Refresh.
10. You should now be able to find the album or EP under Albums.
11. Plug in earphones to the Android and you're there. Beware of listening to extended periods of music with the volume setting on high, as it may damage your hearing.
